**Counties Settle Family's Lawsuit for Death of Bertram Hiscock in Yuba County Jail**

The family of Bertram Hiscock and the Counties of Yuba and Sutter reached a settlement in the federal lawsuit brought by Mr. Hiscock's family regarding his death in the Yuba County Jail on January 29, 2017. Sutter-Yuba Behavioral Health provided mental health services in the Yuba County Jail at the time of Mr. Hiscock's incarceration.

The Parties agreed to settle the family's claims for 1 million dollars, with \$500,000 to be paid by each County.

The case was filed in federal court in the Eastern District of California on December 28, 2017, Case No. 2:17-cv-02706-JAM-GGH.

Mr. Hiscock's family and estate were represented by partners Lori Rifkin and Dan Stormer of Hadsell Stormer & Renick LLP.
